Outcome of 2016-17 Institution Annual Monitoring

Thank you for participating in the 2016-17 Institution Annual Monitoring (IAM) exercise.

As you are aware, IAM is one of the University's key mechanisms for monitoring the performance of teaching institutions that are candidates to be recognised under the Teaching Institutions Recognition Framework (TIRF). The process allows the University to gather, confirm and analyse information in a systematic way and to make decisions that assure the quality of the student experience.

The University convened an IAM Executive Group of senior officers from both the University of London and the Member Institutions that provide academic direction for the International Programmes to consider the information that we have gathered and to make decisions regarding that information.

The IAM Executive Group considered information from this and previous years' IAM exercises and paid particular regard to student recruitment and retention, student performance at course and programme level, the student experience and progress against recommendations made during any Institution Periodic Review.


The IAM Executive Group has now concluded this process and was pleased to note that examination results for the Bachelor of Law (LLB) were of an exceptional standard. Accordingly, I am writing to commend Themis School of Law on the exceptional examination performance for these programmes.

The IAM Executive Group noted that recruitment is stable and that the total number of students is rising. Further to this, it was noted that the panel at the recent IPR guided the teaching centre to make suitable adjustments to accommodate the rising total number of students.

The commendation and the observations were reported to the Institutions Sub-Committee of the University of London International Academy and endorsed by the Board of the University of London International Academy.
